

# BOARD BRIEFS

## Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Regular Meeting on Tuesday, February 7, 2017 the Board of Education discussed/took action on the following item:

- Authorized participation in the Schools of Choice Program as permitted by Section 105/105c of the State School Aid Act, accepting unlimited grades K-11 and limited grade 12 nonresident students for enrollment who reside within Wayne County ISD (RESA) or contiguous districts for the 2017-18 school year. *The open enrollment period for grades K-11 will be April 10-August 18, 2017. The open enrollment period for grade 12 will be April 24-May 12, 2017.*
- Approved the purchase of fitness center equipment at Annapolis High School from All-Pro Exercise, Inc. at a cost of \$14,356.90. Monies will be derived from the General Fund-Athletics.
- Approved the purchase of 134 Epson BrightLink LCD projectors from CDW, utilizing the REMC purchase/bid contract, at a cost of \$176,210 as presented. Monies will be derived from the Technology Bond.
- Awarded the bid for custodial cleaning services at the district's four (4) elementary buildings to The Professional Group (TPG) as specified by duly processed bid tabulation at a cost of \$166,983 as presented (one year agreement).
