

BOARD BRIEFS

Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Special Meeting on Thursday, June 15, 2017 the Board of Education discussed/took action on the following item:

- A motion to allow disclosure and discussion of Jennifer Mast's interim and proposed superintendent contract negotiations failed.
- Board members discussed moving forward with the 2017-18 interim superintendent search process. Board members agreed to have Mr. John Silveri of the Michigan Leadership Institute bring forward the names of potential interim superintendents and present them at the June 20th Board of Education meeting. Internal, as well external candidates, will be considered to serve in an interim capacity for up to one year.
- President LeBar gave notice that at the June 20th board meeting, she will seek rescension of the failed motion regarding Jennifer Mast's contract as District 7 Superintendent of Schools.
- Conducted an open session hearing in response to a complaint initiated by Interim Superintendent Mast. The complaint alleged that Board Secretary Vickie Bracken disclosed closed session information to her daughter. Member Bracken denied the allegations and stated she found the complaint offensive. There was no further discussion.
- President LeBar allowed Interim Superintendent Mast to read a statement addressing allegations against her made by an individual named "Sandy Beach" on Facebook.
- President LeBar allowed Member Diroff to read a statement responding to the recent hostile Facebook dialogue and she shared her views regarding Mrs. Mast's contract negotiations and the reasons why she voted no on Mrs. Mast's contract.
