

BOARD BRIEFS

Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Regular Meeting on Tuesday, March 1, 2016 the Board of Education discussed/took action on the following items:

- Following two (2) public hearings, Dr. Claudia Portscheller, Sex Education Supervisor, reported to the Board on the additional middle school sex education curriculum (specifically grade 6) that was developed/selected by the Advisory Board based on parent survey data and student needs. A resolution to adopt the additional middle school sex education curriculum followed under “Superintendent’s Recommendations.”
- Business Manager Brandy Nusser reviewed the 2015-16 revised fund budgets. A resolution to approve the 2015-16 revised budgets followed under “Superintendent’s Recommendations.”
- Business Manager Brandy Nusser outlined the revised deficit elimination plan that coincides with the revised budget. A resolution to approve the revised DEP followed under “Superintendent’s Recommendations.”
- District and building administrators provided a K-12 academic performance review which included NWEA and M-Step results.
- Adopted the middle school (specifically grade 6) sex education curriculum as presented, effective second semester of the 2015-16 school year. Proposed curriculum is based upon the recommendation of the Sex Education Advisory Board.
- Approved the revised 2015-16 budgets presented with revenues, expenditures and fund balances as of June 30, 2016 noted as follows:

- Approved a four (4) day field trip for Pardee fifth grade students to YMCA Storer Camp in Jackson, Michigan, November 8-11, 2016 as presented. This trip is sponsored by Pardee fifth grade teachers. Costs will be covered per Board policy. The Board also approved a four (4) day field trip for Pardee fifth grade students to YMCA Storer Camp for the 2017-18 school year, dates to be determined.

- A resolution to approve usage of four (4) additional District credit cards for the 2016 calendar year failed.
- A resolution to approve the first reading of several proposed revised Board Bylaws and Policies as presented failed.
