Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Regular Meeting on Tuesday, July 19, 2016 the Board of Education discussed/took action on the following items:

- Mr. Walt Prusiewicz, Dearborn Heights City Clerk, reported the city is seeking election poll workers for upcoming elections. Individuals will be compensated for their time; please call Mr. Prusiewicz at 313-791-3432 for details.
- Appointed and approved the contract of Melanie Ward, O.W. Best Middle School Principal, effective August 22, 2016 in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract presented.
- Accepted the resignation of Jennifer Bennion, teacher, effective June 28, 2016.
- Adopted the revised Deficit Elimination Plan to be submitted to the Michigan Department of Education as presented.
- Approved a resolution authorizing issuance of notes in anticipation of state school aid (August 2016 borrowing through the Michigan Finance Authority).
- Approved the first reading of the proposed revised Board Policy as presented:

Policy #5136 Personal Communication Devices (Revised)
- Approved a resolution supporting a regional enhancement millage proposal for 2 mills for a period of six (6) years, 2016 to 2021 inclusive, at the state general election to be held on November 8, 2016.
- Approved the June, 2016 Cash Flow Analysis Report (following discussion).
- Approved the invoiced purchases and checks for the General Fund as listed in the amount of \$2,005,141.96 (following discussion).
- Approved a three-year contract with the MEA, Educational (Building) Administrative Assistants Unit, for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019 as presented.
