Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Regular Meeting on Tuesday, October 6, 2015 the Board of Education discussed/took action on the following items:

- Mr. Mark Brenton, Polk School Principal and host of tonight's Board of Education meeting, provided Board members/meeting attendees with a short tour of Polk School as it now exists, grades 2-3.
- Mr. Brenton reported on NWEA (Northwest Evaluation Association) MAP (Measures of Academic Progress). These are assessment tests in reading and math used to monitor progress and identify students' instructional levels. Teachers can then access MAP data to gain a better understanding of how to respond to the students' learning needs. Mr. Brenton also outlined the use of Professional Learning Communities (PLC's) to improve instructional practices within the classrooms.
