Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Regular Meeting on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 the Board of Education discussed/took action on the following items:

- Interim Superintendent Jeff Bartold reported that the 2016-17 fall student count is tentatively at 2,646.
- Principal Melanie Ward and teacher Jennifer Mast outlined an at-risk intervention plan for O.W. Best Middle School that includes a Student Responsibility Center and an At-Risk Interventionist position.
- Authorized administration (by verbal consensus) to seek Request for Proposals (RFPs) for a facility cleaning service to assume coverage of current PESG custodial positions in District 7.
- Approved a one (1) day field trip to Cedar Point (Sandusky, Ohio) on June 9, 2017 for eighth grade students at O.W. Best Middle School as presented. All costs are the responsibility of the students/parents, with assistance from the PTO. This trip is sponsored by the eighth grade teachers.
