Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Regular Meeting on Wednesday, February 7, 2018 the Board of Education discussed/took action on the following items:

- Secretary LeBar read a note from District 7 teacher/coach Vic McGuire thanking the Board of Education for recognizing his dedicated service to the district's wrestling program by naming the Annapolis High School wrestling room in his honor.
- Annapolis High School staff presented a proposal to board members on nine (9) new course offerings at Annapolis High School that would be effective the 2018-19 school year. The classes are new, innovative courses that provide alternative options for our students. A resolution followed under "Superintendent's Recommendations."
