

BOARD BRIEFS

Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Special Meeting on Wednesday, August 29, 2018 the Board of Education discussed/took action on the following item:

- Held a two-hour long discussion on key dates and deliverables for the superintendent's 2018-19 evaluation. The session was moderated by Scott Morrell, Michigan Association of School Boards (MASB) consultant.

Board members came to a consensus on the following:

- Superintendent Mast was charged with the following five (5) priorities for 2018-19:
 1. Student Growth (supt eval item G)
 2. Strategic Plan (supt eval item G)
 3. Staff Retention (supt eval item D1)
 4. Communication (supt eval item A3)
 5. Improving Finances/Enrollment (supt eval item D5)
- The Board of Education was charged with the following three (3) goals for 2018-19:
 1. Strategic Plan Review
 2. Development of Board Procedures Document
 3. Formal Student Interactions
- Timeline for the 2018-19 evaluation of Superintendent Mast will be July-June. There will be an Informal Update in October 2018, Formal Discussion and Check-In on Progress toward Goals in December 2018, and another Informal Update in February 2019. Ms. Mast's annual evaluation will take place in May 2019.
- Superintendent Mast will provide board members with a spreadsheet indicating progress toward current goals/objectives, to create a baseline.
- "Assessment Data Discussion" will be a standing item on all forthcoming board agendas.
