

BOARD BRIEFS

Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Regular Meeting on Tuesday, September 5, 2017 the Board of Education discussed/took action on the following items:

- Secretary Bracken read a letter from the Michigan High School Athletic Association acknowledging no negative officials reports for the 2016-17 school year. This is a credit to District 7 student athletes, coaches, staff and the community for demonstrating positive sportsmanship.
- Superintendent Mast reported that she and Assistant Superintendent Brock visited classrooms on September 5th welcoming students and staff back to school. A very preliminary district student count is 2,657 with 1,166 of those being Schools of Choice students. Elementary shuttle bus service will begin on September 6th.
- Superintendent Mast reported that the Dearborn Heights Police Department is interested in a collaboration with District 7 regarding access to the district's exterior surveillance cameras.
- Board members and administration discussed hiring package parameters for an additional PESG full-time custodian. A resolution approving an amended hiring package followed under "Superintendent's Recommendations."
