

BOARD BRIEFS

Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Regular Meeting on Tuesday, October 17, 2017 the Board of Education discussed/took action on the following items:

- Mr. Alan Panter of the accounting firm Yeo & Yeo, distributed and reviewed the 2016-17 District 7 audit report. Mr. Panter was pleased that the district ended the 2016-17 fiscal year with a fund balance of \$322,497.
- Accepted the 2016-17 audit report as presented.
- Accepted a \$1,447.68 cash donation from the Annapolis High School Class of 2016 as presented.
- Approved Annapolis High School extra-curricular clubs/activities for the 2017-18 school year as presented.
- Approved O.W. Best Middle School extra-curricular clubs/activities for the 2017-18 school year as presented.
- Awarded the bid for the roof replacement (with alternate add-on) at Eton Center to Newton Crane Roofing, Inc., as specified by duly processed bid tabulation at a cost of \$194,500 from Building & Site funds.
- Postponed making a decision on the purchase of a new Ford F-250 pick-up truck pending review of the district's existing pick-up truck maintenance records and an evaluation of its current mechanical state. The district's current pick-up truck is a year 2000 Ford F-350 that has 49,742 miles on it and it has been used primarily for snow plowing.
- Entered into an agreement with Elite Fund, Inc., to provide USF E-Rate and Technology Plan Services for the 2017-18 school year as a cost not to exceed \$1,000 as presented. Funds will be derived from the General Fund.
- Approved the Learning A-Z license renewal for grades K-5 for the 2017-18 school year in the amount of \$10,996.00 as presented. Funds will be derived from Title I and the General Fund.
- Authorized administration to place one (1) certified staff member on laid-off status effective immediately, due to economic uncertainty.
