Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Regular Meeting on Tuesday, November 7, 2017 the Board of Education discussed/took action on the following items:

- It was reported that at this time, Mr. Nicholl, Director of Operations, is no longer seeking to purchase a new Ford F350 pick-up truck with plow package. He will re-evaluate the need for the 2018-19 school year.
