

# BOARD BRIEFS

## Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Regular Meeting on Wednesday, October 3, 2018 the Board of Education discussed/took action on the following items:

- Secretary LeBar read a note of appreciation from Susan Mitchell, District 7 Retiree, thanking the Board of Education for the gift she received upon her retirement.
- Annapolis High School spring, 2018 advanced placement test results were shared as part of administration's periodic assessment data presentations.
- A resolution to increase the District 7 Technology Coordinator's annual salary from \$51,000 to \$60,000 failed.
- Approved the purchase of a 2019 Ford F-350 pick-up truck with plow package from Gorno Ford at a total cost (including financing) of \$42,682 as presented, per the MiDeal state bid contract with Ford Credit municipal financing. Monies will be derived from the General Fund and financed in three (3) annual payments of \$14,227 with a \$1.00 final payment buy-out.
- Awarded the bid for custodial cleaning services at the district's four (4) elementary buildings to Enviro-Clean Services, Inc., as specified by duly processed bid tabulation at a cost of \$220,107.88 as presented (one-year agreement).
