

BOARD BRIEFS

Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Regular Meeting on Wednesday, October 17, 2018 the Board of Education discussed/took action on the following items:

- Secretary LeBar read a press release announcing Mr. Victor McGuire (former District 7 teacher/coach) has been selected for induction into the Michigan Wrestling Association Hall of Fame, Class of 2018.
- Mr. Fred Marinucci, Sodexo General Manager, presented a food service year-end review for 2017-18, noting a fund surplus of \$39,753.94, and outlined expectations for the 2018-19 school year.
- Superintendent Jennifer Mast announced that in conjunction with 2018-19 Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS) efforts, administration will be recognizing District 7 students with perfect attendance on a monthly basis. Each student will receive a recognition token and two students per school will be invited to the first board meeting of the month.
- Mr. Kevin Brock, Assistant Superintendent, shared the 2018-19 District School Improvement Plan with board members. The goals encompassed in the plan focus on math, reading and Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS).
- Superintendent Mast shared baseline NWEA math and reading data for grades K-8 as part of administration's periodic assessment data presentations.
- Superintendent Mast shared her first 2018-19 evaluation process periodic review with board members. The board was able to see the evidence that Ms. Mast has documented, thus far, toward each of the MASB standards. The board has one week to submit questions to President Diroff regarding this first review, which Ms. Mast will answer publicly at the next board meeting.
- Accepted the resignation of Teresa Davis, Business Manager, effective October 10, 2018.
- Approved the certified staff appointment of Shadia Berry, Elementary Counselor, effective October 22, 2018.
- Approved Annapolis High School extra-curricular clubs/activities for the 2018-19 school year as presented.
- Approved O.W. Best Middle School extra-curricular clubs/activities for the 2018-19 school year as presented.

- Briefly discussed the draft Board Operating Procedures document before determining this topic should be reserved for a special board meeting.
- Board members summarized their student interaction forums that were held on October 15, 16 and 17 at Annapolis, Pardee and Polk Schools, respectively. This is a required component of the superintendent's evaluation process.
